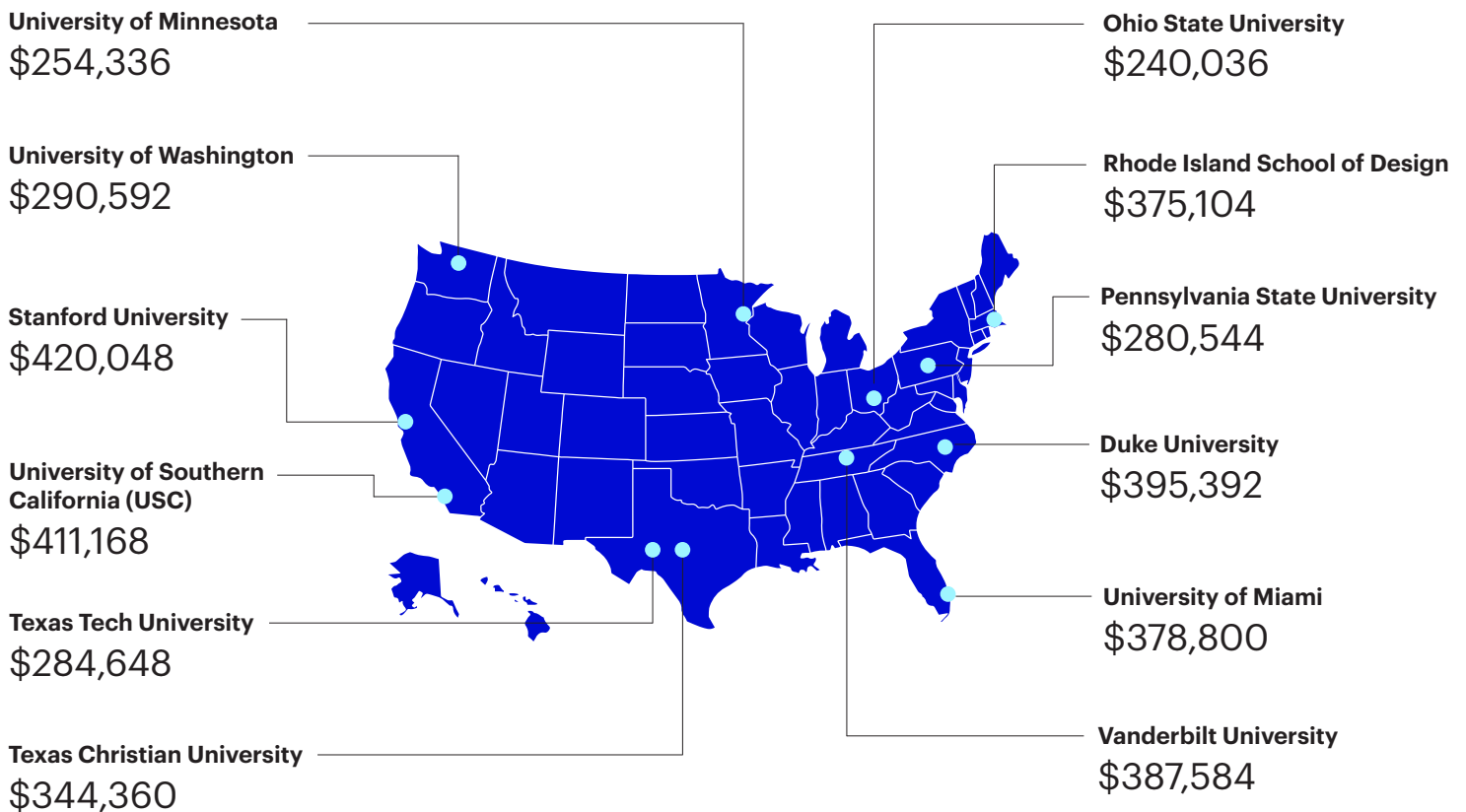


College costs can impact a students' choices
