Fund description


The Invesco Russell 1000 Equal Weight ETF (Fund) is based on the Russell 1000® Equal Weight Index (Index). The Fund will invest at least 90% of its total assets in the securities that comprise the index. The Index is composed of securities in the Russell 1000® Index and is equally weighted across 11 sector groups with each security within the sector receiving equal weight. The Fund and Index are re-weighted at the close of the close of third Friday in March, September, and December. It is also re-weighted at the close of the last Friday in June when the Russell 1000 Index is reconstituted.



Weighted Average Return on Equity is net income divided by net worth.

Weighted Market Capitalization is the sum of each underlying securities market value.
