Weighted average life (WAL), as it applies to money market funds, is calculated in the same manner as the WAM, but is based solely on the periods of time remaining until the securities held in the fund's portfolio (a) are scheduled to be repaid or (b) would be repaid upon a demand by the fund without reference to when interest rates of securities within the fund are scheduled to be readjusted. **Weighted average effective maturity (WAM)** is a measure, as estimated by the fund's portfolio managers, of the length of time the average security in a bond fund will mature or be redeemed by its issuer. It takes into account mortgage prepayments, puts, adjustable coupons and potential call dates. Pursuant to SEC Rule 2a-7, the Fund is required to maintain at least 30% of its total assets in "7-day Liquidity" each time a security is acquired. 7-day liquidity assets include cash; direct US Government obligations, Government securities that are issued at a discount to the principal amount to be repaid at maturity and have a remaining maturity of 60 days or less and securities that will mature or are subject to a demand feature that is exercisable and payable within five business days.
