Fund Description

The PowerShares DWA Developed Markets Momentum Portfolio is based on the Dorsey Wright® Developed Markets Technical Leaders Index (DWA Developed Markets Technical Leaders Index). The Fund will normally invest at least 90% of its total assets in securities of developed economies within Dorsey, Wright & Associates' classification definition, as well as American depository receipts (ADRs) and global depository receipts (GDRs) based on securities in the Index. This Index includes approximately 100 companies from the NASDAQ Developed Markets Ex United States Index that possess powerful relative strength characteristics. The Index excludes US companies listed on a US stock exchange. The Index is computed using the net return, which withholds applicable taxes for non-resident investors. The Fund and the Index are rebalanced and reconstituted quarterly.

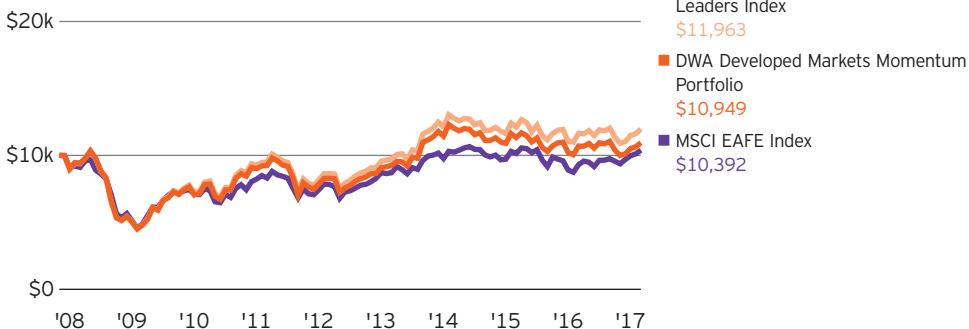

The **Intraday NAV** is a symbol representing estimated fair value based on the most recent intraday price of underlying assets. **Volatility** is the annualized standard deviation of index returns. **Sharpe Ratio** is a risk-adjusted measure calculated using standard deviation and excess return to determine reward per unit of risk. A higher Sharpe Ratio indicates better risk-adjusted

performance. **Correlation** indicates the degree to which two investments have historically moved in the same direction and magnitude. **Alpha** is a measure of performance on a risk-adjusted basis. **Weighted Harmonic Average Stock Price-to-Earnings Ratio (P/E Ratio)** is the share price divided by earnings per share. It is measured on a 12-month trailing basis. **Weighted Harmonic Average Stock Price-to-Book-Value Ratio (P/B Ratio)** is the ratio of a stock's market price to a company's net asset value. **Weighted Harmonic Average** is a method of calculating an average value that lessens the impact of large outliers and increases the impact of small ones. **Weighted Average Return on Equity** is net income divided by net worth. **Weighted Market Capitalization** is the sum of each underlying securities' market value. The **30-Day SEC Yield** is based on a 30-day period and is computed by dividing the net investment income per share earned during the period by the maximum offering price per share on the last day of the period. The **30-Day SEC Unsubsidized Yield** reflects the 30-day yield if the investment adviser were not waiving all or part of its fee or reimbursing the fund for part of its expenses. Total return would have also been lower in the absence of these temporary reimbursements or waivers. **Beta** is a measure of risk representing how a security is expected to respond to general market movements. **Smart Beta** represents an alternative and selection index based methodology that seeks to outperform a benchmark or reduce portfolio risk, or both. Smart beta funds may underperform cap-weighted benchmarks and increase portfolio risk.

Typically, security classifications used in calculating allocation tables are as of the last trading day of the previous month.
