Fund Description

The Invesco Water Resources ETF (Fund) is based on the Nasdaq OMX US Water Index. The Fund generally will invest at least 90% of its total assets in common stocks and American depository receipts (ADRs) and global depository receipts (GDRs) of companies in the water industry that comprise the Underlying Index. The Underlying Index seeks to track the performance of US exchange-listed companies that create products designed to conserve and purify water for homes, businesses and industries. The Fund and the Index are rebalanced quarterly and reconstituted annually in April.

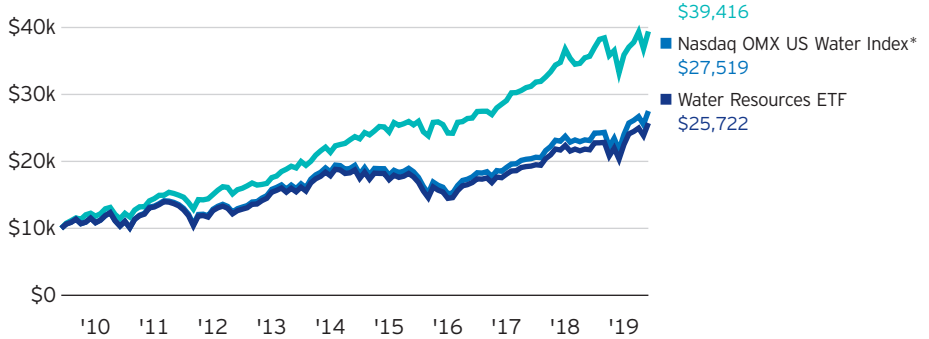

The **Intraday NAV** is a symbol representing estimated fair value based on the most recent intraday price of underlying assets. **Volatility** is the annualized standard

deviation of index returns. **Beta** is a measure of relative risk and the slope of regression. **Sharpe Ratio** is a risk-adjusted measure calculated using standard deviation and excess return to determine reward per unit of risk. A higher Sharpe Ratio indicates better risk-adjusted performance. **Correlation** indicates the degree to which two investments have historically moved in the same direction and magnitude. **Alpha** is a measure of performance on a risk-adjusted basis. **Weighted Harmonic Average Stock Price-to-Earnings Ratio (P/E Ratio)** is the share price divided by earnings per share. It is measured on a 12-month trailing basis. **Weighted Harmonic Average Stock Price-to-Book-Value Ratio (P/B Ratio)** is the ratio of a stock's market price to a company's net asset value. **Weighted Harmonic Average** is a method of calculating an average value that lessens the impact of large outliers and increases the impact of small ones. **Weighted Average Return on Equity** is net income divided by net worth. **Weighted Market Capitalization** is the sum of each underlying securities' market value. The **30-Day SEC Yield** is based on a 30-day period and is computed by dividing the net investment income per share earned during the period by the maximum offering price per share on the last day of the period. The **30-Day SEC Unsubsidized Yield** reflects the 30-day yield if the investment adviser were not waiving all or part of its fee or reimbursing the fund for part of its expenses. Total return would have also been lower in the absence of these temporary reimbursements or waivers.

Typically, security classifications used in calculating allocation tables are as of the last trading day of the previous month.
