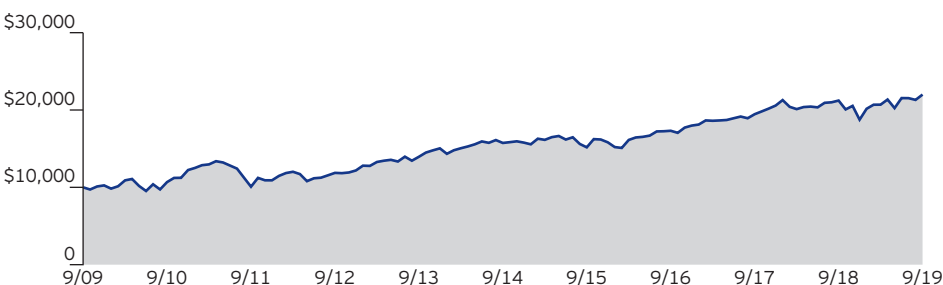

The **up and down capture** measures how well a manager was able to replicate or improve on periods of positive benchmark returns and how severely the manager was affected by periods of negative benchmark returns. **Standard deviation** measures a fund's range of total returns and identifies the spread of a fund's short-term fluctuations.
