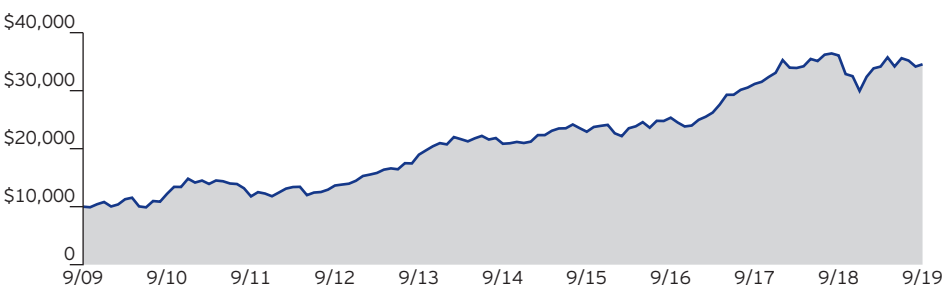

The fund holdings are organized according to the Global Industry Classification Standard, which was developed by and is the exclusive property and service mark of MSCI Inc. and Standard & Poor's.

The Custom Invesco Oppenheimer International Small-Mid Company Index is composed of the MSCI All Country World ex USA Small Cap Index from Nov. 17, 1997, through Sept. 30, 2015, and the MSCI All Country World ex USA SMID Cap Index from Oct. 1, 2015, to present. Index performance includes total returns from when first available. The MSCI All Country World ex USA Small Cap Index is considered representative of small-cap stocks in developed and emerging markets, excluding the US. The MSCI All Country World ex USA SMID Cap Index Index is considered representative of small- and mid-cap stocks in developed and emerging markets, excluding the US. The indexes are computing using the net return, which withholds applicable taxes for non-resident investors. An investment cannot be made directly in an index.

Alpha (cash adjusted) is a measure of performance on a risk-adjusted basis. **Beta** (cash adjusted) is a measure of relative risk and the slope of regression. The **up and down capture** measures how well a manager was able to replicate or improve on periods of positive benchmark returns and how severely the manager was affected by periods of negative benchmark returns. **Standard deviation** measures a fund's range of total returns and identifies the spread of a fund's short-term fluctuations. **Other Markets Exposure** includes frontier/pre-emerging and uncategorized markets.

Ratings are based on a risk-adjusted return measure that accounts for variation in a fund's monthly performance, placing more emphasis on downward variations and rewarding consistent performance. Open-end mutual funds and exchange-traded funds are considered a single population for comparison purposes. Ratings are calculated for funds with at least a three year history. The overall rating is derived from a weighted average of three-, five- and 10-year rating metrics, as applicable, excluding sales charges and including fees and expenses. Had fees not been waived and/or expenses reimbursed currently or in the past, the Morningstar rating would have been lower. Class A shares received 5 stars for the overall, 5 stars for the three years, 5 stars for the five years and 5 stars for the 10 years. The fund was rated among 122, 122, 99 and 61 funds within the Morningstar Foreign Small/Mid Growth Category for the overall period, three, five and 10 years, respectively.

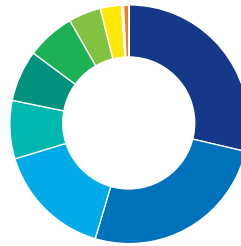
