

## Invesco S&P International Developed Low Volatility ETF

### Fund description

The Invesco S&P International Developed Low Volatility ETF (Fund) is based on the S&P BMI International Developed Low Volatility Index (Index). The Fund will invest at least 90% of its total assets in the securities of companies that comprise the Index. The Index is compiled, maintained and calculated by Standard & Poor's and consists of the 200 least volatile stocks of the S&P Developed ex.-U.S. & South Korea LargeMid Cap BMI Index over the past 12 months. The Index is computed using the net return, which withholds applicable taxes for non-resident investors. Volatility is a statistical measurement of the magnitude of up and down asset price fluctuations over time. The Index is computed using the net return, which withholds applicable taxes for non-resident investors. The Fund and the Index are rebalanced and reconstituted quarterly.

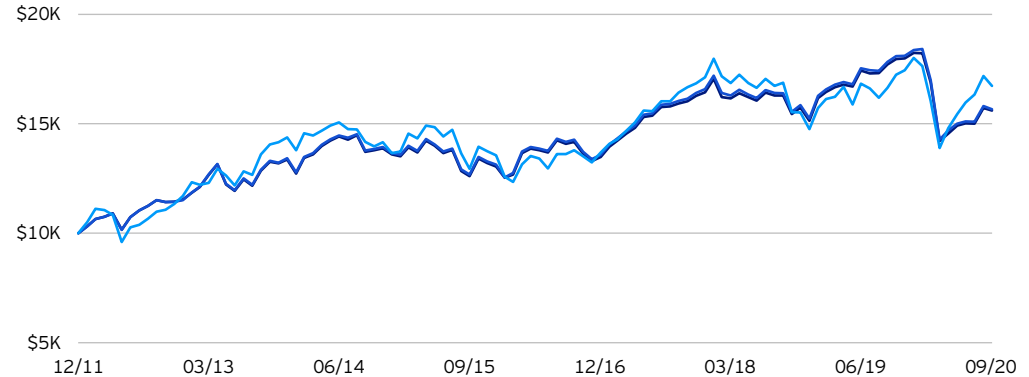

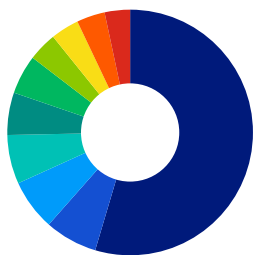

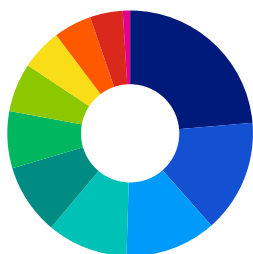

#### Glossary

**30 Day SEC Unsubsidized Yield** reflects the 30-day yield if the investment adviser were not waiving all or part of its fee or reimbursing the fund for part of its expenses. Total return would have also been lower in the absence of these temporary reimbursements or waivers.

**30 Day SEC Yield** is based on a 30-day period and is computed by dividing the net investment income per share earned during the period by the maximum offering price per share on the last day of the period.

**Intraday NAV** is a symbol representing estimated fair value based on the most recent intraday price of underlying assets.

**Weighted Harmonic Average Stock Price-to-Book-Value Ratio (P/B Ratio)** is the ratio of a stock's market price to a company's net asset value.

**Weighted Harmonic Average Stock Price-to-Earnings Ratio (P/E Ratio)** is the share price divided by earnings per share. It is measured on a 12-month trailing basis.

**Weighted Average Return on Equity** is net income divided by net worth.

**Weighted Market Capitalization** is the sum of each underlying securities market value.
